#### **VOICE OF THE EXARCH**

Dear All.

Fraternal greetings to all!

Before all things, I convey the Apostolic Blessing imparted by Holy Father Pope Francis to the Bishop and all the priests, religious and families of the Exarchate of St Ephrem on Wednesday, 11 May 2016, as I met him in the

Audience of the day. The Holy Father was also much pleased to receive greetings of filial devotion, obedience and communion from the Exarchate.

On that day, for the Catechesis, the Holy Father chose Lk 15:11-32 and spoke of the Merciful Father who lovingly accepts both his sons, the younger prodigal son, who thinks that he deserves punishment and the elder son who is with the father always but wants compensation for his service.

#### The Thirteen-Days Lent

This is the liturgical season after the Pentecost. We commemorate the birth and the growth of the early Church, especially the work of the Apostles and the apostolic note of the Church. From 16 to 29 June we observe a lent in spiritual preparation for the commemorations of the Apostles in the Church. On 29 June we venerate the martyrdom of the Apostles Peter and Paul in Rome and celebrate their feast. During the Lenten days, on 19 June, is the feast of St Jude Thaddeus, the Apostle. Happy Feast to all!

#### The Feast of Commemoration of Mar Theophilos Thirumeni

We observe on 27 June the Feast of Commemoration of Jacob Mar Theophilos Thirumeni, the bishop who came to communion with the Catholic Church along with the Servant of God Mar Ivanios and the first Bishop of Tiruvalla. We shall commemorate this blessed Thirumeni in all parishes. For whom it is possible, let them join the Padayatra to the tomb of Mar Theophilos Thirumeni and participate in the services of commemoration in St John's Cathedral Tiruvalla.

#### A New Academic Year Begins

The month of June is important to us. It marks the beginning of a new year, both for secular and ecclesial academic matters. We are awaiting the results of the Board Exams of Classes 10 and 12. The preparations for



the inauguration of the new academic year in schools have begun. I convey to the staff and students, the priests, religious and laity, who are doing a great apostolate through our schools my best wishes and invoke God's grace upon them.

Our Seminarians studying Philosophy in St Charles Seminary Nagpur have done well in their studies. Brothers Justin and Jobin stood first respectively in their Third Year and Second Year Philosophy classes. We are sending Bro. Jerry who completed his Fourth Year Minor Seminary to Dharmaram Vidya Kshetra Bengaluru to pursue studies in Philosophy. Similarly we are sending five of our Seminarians who have completed their Regency to St Mary's Malankara Seminary Trivandrum for studies in Theology and one to Mary Matha Major Seminary, Thrissur. Those of our Seminarians who begin their Theology course were vested in the clerical attire and promoted to the Minor Order of M'samarono on 28 May 2016.

Our Exarchate itself completed one year of its inception and enters a new year, the second year, of its life and activities. "The Ephremite" begins its Second Volume.

#### Inauguration of the Minor Seminary

It is our basic need to have a Minor Seminary. We are grateful to the Eparchy of Gurgaon-Delhi and to Most Rev Jacob Mar Barnabas, that last year our Minor Seminarians could continue their formation in the Girideepam Minor Seminary. Due to lack of space, it is no longer possible. The Diocese of Poona and its Bishop Most Rev Thomas Dabre have let us use a bungalow at Poolgate in the heart of the City of Pune for the next three years as Minor Seminary. We have renovated it. The inauguration of the Minor Seminary is fixed at 3 pm on 18 June 2016. All our faithful are welcome for the inauguration.

I also request our faithful to help our Seminary through sponsorship of seminarians. A brochure on this will be send to the parishes soon. Similarly, you are welcome to sponsor or finance the immediate expenses (renovation, furniture, kitchenware, study aids, computers...) for setting up the seminary at its inauguration.

I am happy to announce that, we will have at least eight new comers to the Minor Seminary this year. We will have a total of 15 seminarians (2 for Second Year, 2 for Third Year, 3 for Fourth Year and 8 for first year) in the



Minor Seminary this year. Bro. Nikhil continues his +2 schooling in Gurgaon (Delhi).

#### Ministry of Evangelisation

I like to share with you that we are making some advances in the field of evangelisation, that is, sharing the joy of the Gospel with those who have not so far come to the light of the Gospel. What hampers our work is the lack of priests, religious and dedicated laity. So let us pray to the "Lord of the harvest to send labourers into the field"!

#### Meetings and their Reporting

While this "voice" is recorded for the June issue of the Ephremite to be sent to the press, we are preparing the report of the meetings of the Priests, Religious and the Pastoral Council. We hope that the meetings will be fruitful and pray for its success. The outcome of the meetings will be reported in the next number (June) of the Ephremite.

The Month of May, rich in activities, elapses on a high note. I thank everyone for their dedication and commitment. The organisers and participants of the Jivan Darshan Camp and the Vocation Camps deserve great appreciation.

Those who promoted vocations to the Minor Seminary are remembered with gratitude. We owe our gratitude to all our benefactors, well-wishers and collaborators.

I have received a list of 13 Lay People from the various parishes of the Exarchate who are undergoing formation to be members of the third batch of Sabhathala Suviseshasangham. They prepare themselves to receive the kaiveppu on 15 July, on the Feast of Commemoration of the Servant of God Mar Ivanios. Let us pray for them!

#### **EXARCHIAL NEWS**

#### 1. Bishop Thomas Mar Anthonios visits the Holy Father

Our Exarch, Aboon Thomas Mor Anthonios, on behalf of our Exarchate, as it completes one year of its erection by the Holy Father, visited him in the Audience of 11 May 2016. He conveyed to the Holy Father the greetings, obedience and love of the Faithful of the Exarchate and obtained an apostolic blessing for the Exarchate.

#### 2. Erection of a New Parish at Dombivli

After many years of prayerful anticipation by the Faithful, a new parish at Dombivli was erected on 01 May 2016 by His Excellency Bishop Thomas Mar Anthonios OIC (Exarch of St. Ephrem Exarchate of Pune) and appointed Rev. Fr John Britto OIC as its first Vicar. The declaration was read out by Rev. Fr George Mathew OIC the Chancellor of the Exarchate during the concelebrated Holy Qurbono led by the Exarch. In a meeting that followed, along with the Exarch, Rev Fathers Mathai Iranathara OIC, the Protopresbyter of Mumbai District, John Britto OIC, Mathew Varikkatu, the Protopresbyter of Pune District, Sr. Kiran SIC, Pastoral Council members of Mumbai zone and representative from different associations were present. For the Malankara families, numbering about 60, residing in and around Dombivli and Thakurli localities, the erection of the new parish was the culmination of their aspirations. They started with forming of a Unit at Dombivli under leadership of Very Rev. Fr John Berchmans OIC in 2003. The parish will be known as St. Mary's Malankara Syrian Catholic Church, Dombivli.

#### 3. First and Final Profession of DM Sisters

On 28 April 2016, six sisters of the Amala Province of the DM Congregation made their First and Final Profession. The services began with the Holy Qurbono offered by Bishop Thomas Mar Anthonios OIC followed by the liturgy of the profession. This grace filled function was held at St Mary's Cathedral Church at Khadki in Pune. The Exarchate of St Ephrem rejoices along with the Amala Province of DM Sisters on this blessed occasion.

#### 4. Festal Celebrations - Msgr Mattamana & Fr. Varghese Kaithon

The Exarchate celebrated the feast of the patron saint of Msgr Varghese Mattamana and Rev. Fr Varghese Kaithon on the occasion of the Feast of

St George on 25 April 2016. The celebrations began with prayers led by H. E. Thomas Mar Anthonios OIC. All Rev. Fathers with the name Varghese/George were remembered in the prayer. It was followed by an agape at the Bishop's House Khadki. His Excellency also conveyed His prayers and gratitude to both the fathers on their feast day focusing on their tireless dedication to the Church and to the Exarchate. The presence of the priests and religious from the Pune District added flavour to the celebrations.

#### MCYM Exarchial Senate Meeting

The MCYM Exarchial Senate Meeting was held on 30

April 2016 at St. Mary's Cathedral, Khadki-Pune. 62 members including the office-bearers and the elected members from the various districts in the Exarchate attended the meeting chaired by His Excellency Thomas Mar Anthonios OIC, the Chairman of MCYM in the Exarchate of St. Ephrem, Khadki-Pune. The meeting deliberated upon the various facets of ecclesial life to be made practical in the Exarchate under the leadership of the youth. The meeting empowered the district and the unit level leaders to undertake this endeavour in their respective areas.

His Exacellency delivered the Inaugural Address, while Mr. Saju John, the Exarchate President of MCYM delivered the presidential address. Reports of MCYM activities were presented and were subjected to critical evaluation. Several suggestions were made to streamline the activities in the Exarchate and to enhance the functioning of MCYM in individual Districts and Units by the Bishop, priests and by the participants in general. Statement of Account for the year 2015-16 were presented and approved by the Senate. Subsequently, Fr. Varghese Valikkodath, the Exarchial MCYM Director answered queries and clarified doubts raised by the Senate members regarding several practical aspects of MCYM leadership. Planning of the Yearly Activity for the year 2016-17 was presented and discussed. Msgr Varghese Mattamana introduced the Social Service Society of the Exarchate-SEVA (St Ephrem Vikas Ayojan) to the Senate members in his capacity as Director of SEVA.

#### MCYM Pune District Annual Retreat

For the spiritual enrichment of our youth, the Pune District MCYM spent a day in pray and retreat on 8 May 2016 at St. Thomas MSCC Chinchwad. The theme of the retreat was 'An encounter with Christ'. Fr. Sunil Maria Benedict led the retreat and provided spiritual inputs, with participation of around 80 youths. The retreat began with the Holy Qurbono in English with Choir assisted by the Pune Choir team. HE Thomas Mar Anthonios OIC visited the youths and inspired them through His words of wisdom and encouragement and led the noon prayers. In Bengaluru it was held at St. Mary's Malankara Catholic Church-Hennur and St John's Malankara Catholic Church-Singasandra, in Chennai at St Thomas Malankara Catholic Church-Padi, in Mumbai at St Mary's Malankara Catholic Church-Sakinaka and in Pune at St. Mary's Malankara Catholic Church-Khadki. The camps were conducted by the Exarchial team led by Rev. Fr. Varghese Valikkodath, Fr. George Mathew OIC, Bros. Justin John, Joseph Dinakaran, Paul Peter, Thomas Attumallil and Paul Vettikattil.

Dear Rev. Fathers, Rev. Sisters, Headmasters, Teachers and Students of Sunday School,

Prayerful Greetings from the Exarchial Commission for Faith Formation!

We celebrate the First Anniversary of the Inauguration of the Exarchate and the Installation of the Apostolic Exarch today. Let us sincerely thank the Almighty Lord for all the blessings He showered upon us through the past one year. The Department of Catechesis is thankful to all of you for the genuine support and the sincere efforts you undertook for the faith formation of our children in the Exarchate.

We are at the threshold of a new Academic Year, 2016 – '17, which has to be inaugurated on 12 June 2016. Even though we are adhering to the existing System in the Department, certain necessary modifications are inevitable for the progressive growth of the Department in the Exarchate. A detailed analysis of the existing System and an elaborate discussion on the proposed amendments will happen in the Exarchal Commission for Faith Formation in the presence and guidance of the Apostolic Exarch in the month of September 2016.

With the strong suggestion from the Pastoral Council (27 May 2016) and by the directive of the Apostolic Exarch, the Department of Catechesis announces the commencement of Class XI from this Academic Year onwards. All students who have passed Class X this year are obliged to attend the regular Catechism Classes without fail. But they will be promoted to MCYM and no longer be considered as part of MCCL.

A list of Class X students who have written the Examination in 2015 – '16 is attached for your reference. Those who are marked in green have successfully completed the course. Kindly go through the list and notify me through a separate email if there is any correction in the spelling of the names either of the student or of the guardian.

The conditions for the successful completion of the course are as follows:

- 1. Appeared for both First Semester and Second Semester Examinations.
- 2. Obtained atleast 35 marks as aggregate of the two Semesters.

Those who are marked in Red have not got 35 marks as aggregate and those who are marked in blue have missed either one of the Semester Examination.

Since we are beginning Class XI this year itself, a chance for improvement is given for those who have not cleared the Class X examination. An Improvement Examination is scheduled to be held on 19 June 2016 at 11 am in the respective Parishes with a Question Paper set from the Centre. The Answer Sheets will be evaluated at the Centre and the Results will be announced latest by 25 June 2016.

The options for the Improvement Examination are as follows:

 Those who have not obtained 35 marks as aggregate even after appearing in two Semesters have to appear for either one or both of the Semester Improvement Examinations and get 35 marks as aggregate.

Those who have not appeared for any one of the two Semester Examinations have to write the corresponding Semester Improvement Examination and obtain 35 marks as aggregate.

Those who have got A+, A and B+ Grades in Class X will be honoured with Gold, Silver and Bronze Medals correspondingly along with the Certificate. Those who have obtained A+, A and B+ in Classes IV to IX will be awarded with Certificate of Merit. A list comprising of those who have obtained A+, A and B+ in each class is attached herewith for your kind reference.

It is the responsibility of the outgoing Headmaster/Headmistress, if any, to introduce the new Headmaster/Headmistress to the Department. Kindly forward a mail regarding the change along with the name, phone number and email of the new Headmaster/Headmistress.

A survey form to collect the details of the Teachers is attached herewith in order to assess the teaching ministry of them.
