May the glory of the Risen Lord shine upon us and fill our hearts and homes with His peace!

# Foundation Stone Laying of our Exarchial Centre

It was indeed a great moment of unity, solidarity, communion and brotherliness that we experienced at the Foundation Stone Laying of our Exarchial Centre at Kharsundi Village near Khopoli on 16 March 2017. I thank all the parishes of our Exarchate, especially the parishes of the Mumbai-Pune Ecclesiastical Districts. When you turned out in large numbers, in spite of the hostile climate, in spite of the day being a working day, in spite of other difficulties, our Bavathirumeni was exhilarated; the people of Kharsundi village came to know, who we are; all of us were so encouraged! The Organisers did plan well and executed the plan with perfection. Hearty congratulations! Without naming anyone, but keeping each one in my heart, I extend hearty gratitude to one and all, to our beloved Bavathirumeni, our beloved Barnabas Thirumeni, dear Achans, Sisters, Elders, Youth and Children. We are the Church and we build up our Church!

Dear All, we have made a master plan for the development of the plot we have purchased. We have a dream to realise. It will take time. Our present priority is to build up the infrastructure for our Minor Seminary, as I discussed in our Exarchial Pastoral Council and Exarchial Finance Council. It is our earnest desire that every member of our Church raise an amount, according to each one's capacity, through "Donate a Brick" action, a brick, equivalent to one sq ft with a cost of construction of Rs 2000. We are planning to reach out to each member and family of our Exarchate with the brochure.

# Visits to Missions

The last month was important for me in directing our missionary

activities, evangelisation and social work programmes. I clubbed my visit to our parish in Nagpur with a visit to the mission work taken up by the Amala Province of the Congregation of the Daughters of Mary in the Eparchy of Chanda. Rev. Fr Samuel Thoppil was also with me. Similarly on 17 March 2017, together with Rev. Fr Jose Konnathuvila and Rev. Fr Mathew Thazhethottathil, I visited the village missions of the Vincentian Fathers in the Ahmednagar District of Maharashtra. On 22 March. together Rev. Fathers Vijoy Varghese Thekkepookalam OIC, Zacharias Nanthiattu OIC, Joseph Menakaleeckal OIC and George Mathew OIC, I visited Most Rev. Robert Miranda, Bishop of Gulbarga, to open a village mission which will be taken up by the Bethany Navajyothi Province. An then on 24 March 2017, we Msgr Varghese Mattamana, Fr Varghese Kadakketh, Fr Joel Mathew OIC, Mr James from Bengaluru and Mr Sunny Pawath from Mumbai and I visited Kamagiri in Tamil Nadu and Devanahalli near Benagaluru to study the mission works undertaken by our parishes in Bengaluru. All these gave me practical knowledge of sharing the joy of the Gospel with those who have not come to the same. The visit taught me well that the knowledge of language, culture and religion coupled commitment is the key to open up village missions.

# **Sunday School Examinations**

The Exarchial Commission for Faith Formation and our Sunday School Teachers are doing their best to organise the annual examination of the Sunday School to be held on 23 April. May our children, through the exams see how well they have encountered Jesus in their life! I urge all parents to motivate the children to prepare well for the exams. God has the priority of our life! All possible adjustments have been made to facilitate the students, even who go for the holidays to their native parishes, to write the annual exams. Repetition of exams will be in June. In spite of these, those who disregard these will not be promoted to the next class.

During a recent parish visit, a group of Sunday School teachers came to me and shared with me how the parents are busy with their children sending them to tuition classes and holiday programmes and nullify all their efforts to attract the children for the Sunday School classes. I told them to do their best and leave the rest to freedom of the parents. Let them decide on their priorities of life!

# **Holiday Programmes**

Summer holiday is a season for refreshing. The refreshment of our spiritual faculties gives physical recuperation! We have a number programmes organised in our Exarchate for our spiritual nourishment. The *Jeevan Darshan* camp for our children, for the children of High School and Higher Secondary grade, for their vocation guidance is a forum for our children for the orientation of their life. The camps in the Exarchial districts of Bengaluru, Chennai, Mumbai and Pune will be held from 25 April to 30 April. The major seminarians of the exarchate along with Rev. Frs. Mathew Punakulam and George Mathew OIC will give leadership for the camps.

Dear Rev. Fathers, Rev. Sisters, Headmasters, Teachers and Students of Sunday School,

Prayerful Greetings from the Exarchial Commission for Faith Formation!

We are nearing the conclusion of the Second Semester. This Semester will come to an end with the Second Semester Examination scheduled to be held at 11.00 am on 23 April 2017. Even though it is little difficult for the students, this is the most appropriate timing available for the Examination in the given situation of the Exarchate. So let us adhere to this decision confirmed in the gathering of the catechism representatives from every Parish on 3 October 2016.

In order to assist those who will be in Kerala during the Second Semester Examination, according to the need of the students, Examination Centres will be provided in the Diocesan Headquarters (Trivandrum, Mavelikkara, Pathanamthitta, Tiruvalla, Muvattupuzha, Bathery). The Headmasters are requested to send a list of students, before 3 April 2017, who wish to write the Examination at any of the above Diocesan Headquarters. Other Centres will be allocated if there are more than 5 students to write the Examination. No requests will be entertained after 3 April.

As usual, JeevanDarshan Camps are planned in Pune, Mumbai, Bengaluru and Chennai Districts of the Exarchate. The Exarchial Brothers who are studying in different Seminaries will lead the Camps. The date and venue of the Camps will be announced in the Districts by the respective District Directors of Catechesis.Fr. George Mathew OIC, the Rector of the Minor Seminary will be in-charge of the Camps.

Hope the Parish and District level elections to the MCYM Secretariat are underway. Kindly adhere to the dates specified in the latest Circular dated 20 February 2017 from the Directorate of Exarchial Commissions. The names to Exarchial Syndicate have to be forwarded to the Directorate as soon as they are decided in the Districts.

# Annual Exarchial Senate and Leadership Meet

As you are already informed, the Annual Senate of the Exarchial MCYM will be held together with a Leadership Meet from 11.00 am on 29 April to 1.00 pm on 1 May 2017. All the members who belong to the Parish Secretariat, the District Syndicate and the Exarchial Syndicate of MCYM arehonourably expected to attend the Leadership Meet without fail. The District Directors are earnestly requested to attend the Annual Senate to be part of the Action Planning for 2017-'18. All Animators and Promoters in the Parish, District and Exarchial level should actively take part in the Annual Senate. A separate Animators and Promoters Gathering is also scheduled for 30 April parallel with the Leadership Meet.

As per the suggestion by the Apostolic Exarch, a Common Minimum Programmefor the Districts and the Parishes has to be drawn in the Annual Senate Meeting. The Districts and the Parishes will be obliged to follow the Common Minimum Programmedecided in the Senate.

As per the suggestion of Global MCYM, the theme of MCYM for this year is 'Youth: Disciples and Witnesses'. Since this theme goes along with the present objective of the Exarchate in general, the Exarchial MCYM decides to accept it without any adaptation. In line with the theme, the Annual Senate and the Leadership Meet is christened as YiELD 2017 (Youth in Evangelization-Leadership-Discipleship). Evangelization and Witness goes hand in hand in Christian context. The Leadership Meet will be led by Mr CC Joseph, the International Co-ordinator of Jesus Youth.

There will be a Cultural Competition on the second day of YiELD 2017 on the theme 'Youth: Disciples and witnesses'. Every District will be given 15 minutes to present the theme in whatever Art form they want. More details of the Competition will be communicated to you soon.

# **Evaluation of MCYM Resource Team Sessions**

MCYM Resource Team Sessions are being held in the Districts and the Parishes for the last few months. Around seven Sessions are completed in most of the Districts. As per the instruction of the Apostolic Exarch in the last Annual Senate and the decision of the members of the Senate, there would be an evaluation of individuals, based on the Resource Team Sessions conducted in the Parish. Taking this into account, there will be a written Examination across the Parishes in the Exarchate from 11 am 1 pm on 23 April 2017. All youth of the Exarchate, irrespective of the days of their attendance in the Resource Team Sessions, are expected to attend the Examination as this will lead to the formal completion of Class XII of Catechism.

The Power Point Presentations used for these Sessions and the corresponding lessons in Class XI and XII Text Books of Catechism form the Syllabus of the Examination. Thorough

reading of the lessons and internalizing it is necessary for taking the Examination with confidence. The detailed mode of the Examination will be communicated to you by MrSaji Daniel and Mrs Julie Philip, the Exarchial Promoters of the Resource Team Formation. The number of Youth taking the Examination from each Parish has to be communicated by the MCYM Secretary to the present District Presidents latest by 3 April 2017.

# Oath Taking of New Office Bearers in the Parishes and the Districts

Oath taking of the new Office Bearers in the Parishes has to be done formally in the Church before the Parish Community on a Sunday after the Holy Qurbono. # Malankara Catholic Youth Movement

# 1. YiELD 2017 Annual Senate and Leadership Meet

The Annual Senate Meeting and Leadership Meet YiELD 2017 (Youth in Evangelization- Leadership-Discipleship) of the Exarchial MCYM is scheduled to

be held from 29 April to 1 May at Pune. The programme will begin at 11.30 am on 29 April with the Holy Qurbono and conclude at 1.00 pm on 1 May with the Valedictory Session. Mr. CC Joseph, Internation Co-Ordinator of Jesus Youth will lead the Leadership Meet. The elections to the new Exarchial MCYM Secretariat will be held in the Annual Senate Meeting held during these days. All Office Bearers of MCYM along with their Animators at the Parish, District and Exarchial level are bound to attend the Leadership Meet without fail.

# 2. MCYM Resource Team Formation in Bangalore

The Seventh Resource Team Training Session for Bangalore District was held on 18 March at St. Mary's Malankara Catholic Church, Hennur. The session on 'St. Paul, the Example to Christians' was led by Mrs. Thangam George and Mr. Shiju John. Around 20 members participated from the four units in Bangalore District including the Animators - Mr. TM Johnson and Mrs. Hema Joseph and Mathikere unit Promoter Mr. Jacob Daniel.

The session began with a prayer by Rev. Fr. Varghese Kadakketh followed by a group activity. The activity required each individual to select two other individuals - one as a personal 'fear' and the other as a 'protector' and move around whilst ensuring that 'fear' never gets between the individual and the 'protector'. This activity based on 'The Theatre of Oppressed' is meant to depict how chaotic it is to run away from our fears and why we always need a Saviour whom we can lean on.

After the activity, Mrs. Thangam began with a brief history of Saul of Tarsus, his background, his deep-rooted belief and scholarly character. A video clip from the movie 'St. Paul' showed Saul, although being a devout Jew, resisted from stoning Stephen. Through several other clips, she brought out the constant tension



that prevailed in the society after the crucifixion of Jesus. The strong Jewish faith of the masses was, for the first time, under threat because of the 'Jesus Movement'. The members went through Saul's journey to Damascus and his transformation to Paul. Paul eventually became a committed missionary who spread the Word of Jesus even though he was never in direct contact with Christ. Paul is an ideal role model for preaching the Gospel even today.

Then Mr. Shiju discussed the unique characteristics of St. Paul that led him to become an ideal instrument for spreading the Word of God. Paul exhibited qualities such as Enthusiasm, Courage, Suffering, Openness, Friendship, Intellectual ability, Standing by the poor and Preaching without remuneration during his tumultuous journey through Asia minor and Rome. Mr. Shiju showed how the Youth today can relate with each of these qualities in our daily life. We all face challenges today just as Paul did but we need to remain resilient in our faith in Christ.

# Malankara Catholic Suvisesha Sangham (MCSS)

1. Suvisesha Sangham Formation Programme, Mumbai

Suvisesha Sangham Formation Session at Mumbai District level was conducted at St. Mary's Church, Sakinaka on 12 March 2017. The programme began with Morning Prayer at 7 am followed by con-celebration of Holy Qurbono by



Rev. Frs. Antony Kakkanatt, Kurian Thondukuzhiyil OIC and Philip Pulipra.

After breakfast, the Sessions started at 10.15 am with songs and prayers. Fr Antony Kakkanatt, the Executive Secretary of Malankara Catholic Suvisesha Sangham started the class in continuation on the topic of 'Christianity is a race and fight' from where he had stopped during his earlier class on20 November 2017. One has to nail his likes, desires and interests and carry his cross if one wants to be with Jesus. If one surrenders everything to God, He will take care of the remaining. One has to wash his heart clean of wickedness so that he may be saved (Jer.4:14).

Fr Antony delved on the subject of faith of ancestors like Abel, Henoch, Noah, Abraham, Isaac, Jacob, Joseph, Moses etc. (Heb.11). We are surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses, so let us lay aside every weight and sin that clings so closely, and let us run with perseverance the race that is set before us, looking up to Jesus the pioneer and perfecter.

Fr Antony also touched the subject of sufferings. God allows sufferings in our life for our betterment and spiritual growth. If we accept our sufferings as virtues and graces, it will be good for us and others.

The second half after lunch was used for the spiritual exercise of *'Lectio Divina'* i.e. Divine reading. Fr Antony read out a Bible portion and explained its inner meanings. Then half of the members individually made a sharing on the verses that touched them and the other half individually made prayers out of the portion read out.

It was announced by Fr. Antony that *'kaiveppu'* of the Suvisesha Sangham members of Mumbai District shall be conducted on 18 June 2017 and he exhorted all members to spiritually prepare themselves for the same.

The programme ended by 4.45 pm with prayer and blessing by Fr Antony.

# 2. Suvisesha Sangham Formation Programme, Bangalore

Bangalore District level Suvisesha Sangham formation classes in Bangalore though started in 2013, from October 2015 onwards the Classes are conducted more frequently and on an average 25 members from all the four Parishes are regularly attending the classes. Sunday School Teachers Seminar, Pune District

by following the guidelines drawn for the 'Suvisesha Sangham' in their daily life,

The last class was conducted by Rev. Fr. Antony Kakkanatt on 11 March 2017 at St. Mary's Church, Hennur wherein he taught the responsibility of each one of us being in Suvisesha Sangham. As every human being has a relationship with God, especially we being Christians are called to maintain that relationship through fellowship, worship and communion, fixing our eyes on Jesus Christ, so that we can get control over all the obstacles and evil temptations, thereby to get rid of all evil thoughts and acts in our life, to become a real Christian.

While the 'Kaiveppu' is planned for 11 June 2017, one more session will be arranged, mostly by April end.

Suvisesha Sangham-Bangalore is thankful to all Rev. Fathers and Sisters who are training us, our vicar Rev. Fr. Varghese Kadakketh and the Hennur Parish Committee for making all the required arrangements to conduct the Formation Classes smoothly.

# 3. Suvisesha Sangham Formation Programme, Chennai

March 2017 at St. Mary's Cathedral, Khadki. The Session, led by Rev. Fr. Antony Kakkanatt, started at 9.30 am with a song followed by a reading from the Holy Scripture *Ephesians* 4:7-11 which was reflected upon.

Post lunch. Fr. Antony taught about '*Lectio Divina*' (divine reading) of the Holy Bible. Reading of the Holy Book has mainly 5 steps: (1) Reading (2) Reflection (3) Prayer (4) Contemplation (5) Application in life.

Later, the Scripture Luke 5: 1-11 was read out and reflected upon. Half of the members shared the specific portion which attracted them. The other half prayed on the basis of this portion. The thoughts reflected upon were to keep away from the shore (to keep away from worldly attractions), put out the net into the deep water (keep deep faith in crises), put out the net as per Jesus' saying (all for His Will), etc.

Though this class was a gist of the earlier sessions, it brought a provocative thought in the minds of the members, to set out for spreading the Good News. It inculcated the feeling that it is our duty to spread the Good News according to the Scripture and also as per the great longing of our Servant of God Mar Ivanios. The session concluded with prayer and blessing by FrAntony.
